John Templeton Jr. MD, Interviewed On ReachOUT.tv

ReachOUT.tv will be airing an interview with John Templeton Jr. MD. After receiving a B.A. degree from Yale University, Dr. Templeton earned an M.D. degree from Harvard Medical School. He completed his internship and residency in surgery at the Medical College of Virginia and trained in pediatric surgery under Dr. C. Everett Koop at The Children's Hospital of Philadelphia. After serving in the U. S. Navy, he returned in 1977, and served on staff as a pediatric surgeon. In 1995, he retired as Professor of Pediatric Surgery at the University of Pennsylvania.

Holding memberships in numerous professional and scientific societies, Dr. Templeton serves as President of the John Templeton Foundation. He is also Chairman of the Board of Templeton Growth Fund, Ltd., which was founded by his father, Sir John Templeton. He is also on the Board of the National Bible Association, in addition to a number of other boards.

Dr. Templeton is married to Dr. Josephine (Pina) Templeton who is retired from the practice of pediatric anesthesiology at The Children's Hospital of Philadelphia. Dr. Templeton's autobiography, *A Searcher's Life*, was published in 1999. In 2004 he wrote *Thrift and Generosity: The Joy of Giving*.

On the ReachOUT.tv show, which is part of ReachOUT.org, Inc., Dr. Templeton discussed the John Templeton Foundation and explained many of the areas this philanthropic organization is involved with. During the interview, Dr. Templeton provided a review of the Templeton Prize winner's walls just installed at their headquarters in Conshohocken, Pa., and discussed the winner of the 2005 Templeton Prize, Dr. Charles Townes. Dr. Townes received \$1.5 Million. The Templeton Prize is awarded annually for progress or research in spiritual matters.

ReachOUT.org, Inc. was started in 1998 and began broadcasting in just 7 towns. Its motto is "Reaching Today's Culture with the Message of Hope," and they highlight the things people do outside of the wall of the church.
